



KINGSTON ESTATE WINES

2007 SAUVIGNON BLANC



This is a fresh, soft and generous wine style with infinite drinkability.

Sauvignon Blanc grapes were selected from premium growing regions throughout Australia, although primarily the Adelaide Hills. Parcels of fruit which showed generous fruit concentration were identified and only the free run juice was used to minimize any phenolics and cool fermentation temperatures were carefully maintained to ensure retention of varietal fruit characters.

The result is a lively approachable wine, well complemented to numerous food styles and dishes.

The 2007` Kingston Estate Sauvignon Blanc is very pale green with pale straw tones.

On the nose it is a typical pungent Sauvignon Blanc with lifted tropical fruit flavours, passionfruit and attractive herbaceous, capsicum characters. The palate is soft and supple with abundant tropical fruit and passionfruit flavours. It has superb drinkability.

The wine is best enjoyed on release. It is an excellent match to fresh seafood, free range chicken and light Asian dishes.
