■ **KINGSTON ESTATE** has added two new wines to its Echelon range, with the release of the Kingston Estate Echelon Petit Verdot 2007 and the Kingston Estate Echelon Shiraz 2007. Regarded as Kingston's flagship label, Echelon wines showcase premium fruit sourced from some of South Australia's best wine growing regions. "Consistent innovation, experimentation and improvement is engrained in our culture," said Kingston Estate owner and winemaker, Bill Moularadellis. "This is the foundation of our Echelon wines." Fruit for the 2007 Echelon Petit Verdot was sourced from vines planted in 1968. The wine was then matured in a combination of French and American barrels to build complexity while enhancing the rich fruit flavours. The 2007 Echelon Shiraz was sourced from Adelaide Plains, Clare Valley and Limestone Coast fruit, resulting in a wine that highlights Kingston Estate's ability to blend across regions. Both wines have an RRP of \$25.
