2011 PINOT GRIS

ADELAIDE HILLS / MT BENSON

This is a fresh, soft and generous wine style with infinite drinkability.

The grapes for the 2011 Pinot Gris were sourced from selected premium vineyards in the cool-climate regions of the Adelaide Hills and Mt Benson.

These regions continue to show a great ability to produce excellent wine exhibiting delicate but lifted aromatic flavours.

The individual parcels were then blended to style, balancing the green herbaceous characters with the tropical passionfruit flavours, and giving the wine length, and fine-tuning the acid structure.

The result is a lively approachable wine, well complemented to numerous food styles and dishes.

The 2011 Kingston Estate Pinot Gris is a pale straw colour with aromatics of violet and rose perfume with stonefruit and melon tones. The palate displays pears and nectarine with a white peach notes, displaying a full and rounded sweet fruit palate.
