2009 PETIT VERDOT

SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Petit Verdot is a unique red variety that thrives in the warmer regions of Australia and in particular the Riverland area of South Australia. This late harvest variety (translation 'the little green one') struggles to ripen in its homeland. Kingston Estate has extensive plantings of Petit Verdot growing in selected deep sandy soils on limestone adjacent to the winery where the grapes consequently reach full ripeness and intensity.

The Petit Verdot grapes were harvested at night and transported to the winery where they were immediately crushed and fermentation commenced. On completion of fermentation the wine was matured with American oak before final blending and preparation for bottling.

The wine is a deep rich bright red colour with purple hues. A bouquet of raspberry, blueberry, violets with floral perfume. A wonderfully full berry palate with a big juicy mouth filling body and a silky soft tannin follows with cinnamon and nutmeg oak complexity.

The wine will cellar and develop for 3 to 4 years.

Food Suggestions

This wine has the versatility to complement almost any dining situation. Try it with rare beef, roast or pork or as an accompaniment with matured cheddar.
